




Icon selection: Short press the button, move the loop to the right, select the icon. **Icon function selection**: Long press the key to achieve the function of the selected icon. Icon Description:


- U: Power off Icon: Corresponding to the "POWER" button of remote

3 : Source Icon: Corresponding to the "SOURCE" button of remote.


- : CH+ Icon: Corresponding to the "CH+" button of remote.


